



TRALI RISK MITIGATION PROTOCOL

To reduce the incidence of Transfusion-related Acute Lung Injury (TRALI), LifeStream utilizes the following multifaceted strategy, in compliance with AABB and College of American Pathologists (CAP) standards and references:

- In compliance with AABB Standard 5.4.1.3, all LifeStream apheresis platelet and plasma products are from donors who are either males, females who have not been pregnant/delivered a baby, or females who have been tested since their most recent pregnancy and found to be negative for HLA antibodies.
- In compliance with AABB Standard 5.4.1.2, LifeStream medical staff thoroughly evaluates all reported cases of possible TRALI to determine if donors involved are eligible to continue donating blood. All donors implicated in a confirmed TRALI case or found to have TRALI-related antibodies are permanently deferred from donation.
